## CALL FOR SYMPOSIA SUBMISSIONS

It's not too early to plan to be a part of ICE 2016 which will be an exciting and historic event.

Symposia submissions are now open, [click here](#). Organize a symposium around your research and share it with this important global audience. Gain exposure for your work and build your worldwide network. Symposia for ICE 2016 will be 3-4 hours in length and will feature 15-minute presentations related to the symposium topic based on [30 identified scientific sections](#). The deadline for submissions is March 2, 2015.

Note that the 2016 Annual Meeting of the Entomological Society of America (ESA), and the Annual Meetings of the Entomological Society of Canada (ESC) and Florida Entomological Society (FES) will be held in conjunction with ICE 2016 and all symposia will be combined in this one event. There will not be a separate submission process for the 2016 ESA or ESC or FES meetings.

## CALL FOR PLENARY SPEAKERS

New with ICE 2016, [submissions for daily plenary speakers](#) will be accepted from anyone in the global entomological community and related disciplines. There are six convenient steps to make a nomination. Each submitter may nominate only one speaker. Submission deadline is October 1, 2014.
